#### Who Should Attend:

The target audience for this course is state and local highway personnel dealing with design, construction, maintenance, and rehabilitation of asphalt pavement.

- 1. Introduction
- 2. Traffic loading
- 3. Basic distress mechanisms
- 4. Drainage
- 5. Pavement evaluation techniques (condition survey, serviceability, structural capacity, friction)
- 6. Maintenance and rehabilitation materials
- 7. Preservation timing and preparation before resurfacing or restoration (crack sealing, patching, milling, leveling course)

- 8. System preservation treatments (fog seal, chip seal, slurry seal and microsurfacing, asphalt rubber)
- 9. Recycling of pavement materials
- 10. Full depth concrete reclamation of distressed asphalt pavements
- 11. Hot mix asphalt overlays
