

AASHTO TC3 EQUIVALENT TRAINING COURSES

<u>AASHTO TC3 online</u> is one tool that AZ Local Technical Assistance Program utilizes as a secondary training resource for local agencies. AZ LTAP typically schedules training on-demand which means there are times when training is not available through our program. As a result, we have identified "equivalent" courses available through AASHTO TC3 that will be accepted upon completion.

HOW TO REGISTER for TRAINING VIA AASHTO TC3 (video link):

- 1. Please use the Google CHROME Browser when completing courses via the AASHTO website.
- 2. Go to https://store.transportation.org/training and find "MyAccount" at the top right of the page. If visiting for the first time, select "Register with AASHTO" and provide the requested information. Please use your government work email address, work address, and work phone number.
 - a. Otherwise, select "Sign In" and enter your government agency email address and password.
- 3. Once on TC3 site members can type into 'Search' any of the 'Item Codes' listed above, search results will bring up the course name listed below, add the course to the Shopping Cart. Click Go to Cart.
- 4. When you are ready to checkout, click Shopping Cart on the top menu and enter the following promotion code and select *Apply*:
 - a. Promotion Code: D5X3-B3D9-52CB-4XCX
- 5. Click Proceed to Checkout, click Review Order, and click Place Order.
- 6. To launch purchased training courses, select "My Training" from the "My Account" drop down menu at the top of the page. This will display a list of purchased courses that you can complete.

RECEIVING CREDIT for COMPLETED AASHTO TC3 TRAINING:

Upon completion, you **MUST** e-mail the certificate of completion or official AASHTO transcript to AZ LTAP at Ttraining@azdot.gov. In the body of the email you MUST include:

- The employee's FULL NAME and EMAIL (if emailing on behalf of an employee).
- The name of the LTAP course you would like the AASHTO equivalent to be applied to.
- Send certificate as a downloadable attachment as items shared via Google Drive cannot be opened.
