

## AZ LTAPs Contributing Member Agencies

### What is a Contributing Member Agency?

Many local agencies receive funding through their Council of Government, Metropolitan Planning Organization or other planning organizations and are already contributing members of AZ LTAP. If you are not yet a member of AZ LTAP, annual fees are just \$100 per transportation employee. We are now accepting administrative employees but participation in the program is limited. Your membership has many benefits, including no further participant registration fee for courses, with exception of a \$20 fee per person for the cost of the First Aid/CPR/AED certification cards. You also have the ability to request training in your location, at a time convenient for you and your employees.
